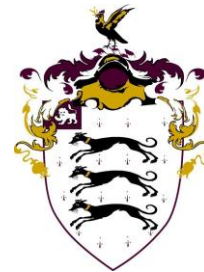
We would like to invite you to spend the morning (or some of the morning) with SJM celebrating the wonderful things that our female relatives do for us.

Smart Watches

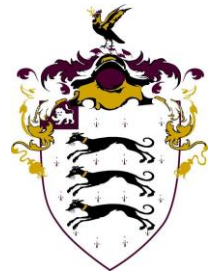
